

A Sign from God? Or Just Another Eclipse?

I think it is extremely important as Christians to *know* the word of God. I'm not super knowledgeable of a lot of things, so I have to search and study with the Holy Spirit as my guide so as not to be deceived. I have learned this the hard way over my many years on this earth. I was one of the people who would (and still catch myself doing if not careful) take something at face value and run with it, only to be embarrassingly corrected (in a loving way) by either a fellow Christian or God Himself to keep me grounded in the truth. By the time you read this, the eclipse will have already happened. This is not a prophecy, for I am not a prophet, this is just my findings while trying to stay grounded in the truth.

Jesus says in Matthew 24:24 "For false messiahs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders to lead astray, if possible, even the elect."

Paul says in 2 Timothy 4:3-4 "For the time will come when people will not tolerate sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, will multiply teachers for themselves because they have an itch to hear what they want to hear. They will turn away from hearing the truth and will turn aside to myths."

John warns in 1 John 4:1-6 "Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see if they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. This is how you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, but every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming; even now it is already in the world. You are from God, little children, and you have conquered them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. They are from the world. Therefore what they say is from the world, and the world listens to them. We are from God. Anyone who knows God listens to us; anyone who is not from God does not listen to us. This is how we know the Spirit of truth and the spirit of

deception."

These are a few among many versus God gave us to make sure we are not deceived. With that in mind here is what I have come to understand.

What is mostly being talked about (in my circles anyway) are the 'coincidences' surrounding the eclipse. I inserted these 'symbols because I don't really believe in coincidences. We all know the story of Jonah (if you don't your missing out! Read the book of Jonah it's really good). You probably first heard of it in Sunday School as a kid. God instructs Jonah to go preach repentance to the city of Nineveh. But Jonah hates those people because of how evil they are and he doesn't feel they deserve God's forgiveness. So he runs away only to be swallowed up by a large sea creature (usually taught as being a whale). He is in there for three days, (type and shadow of Christ's decent into hell), repents and goes to Nineveh. He preaches to the King and citizens then goes and sits outside the city and waits for it to be destroyed because he never thought they would listen to him and repent. Well, they do. Some believe that is because, according to the Assyrian history, there was an eclipse that happened over ancient Nineveh in June of 763 BC. Many people believe this happened when Jonah was preaching and they took it as a sign that God was really speaking to them. We don't know if this all happened at the same time, but it's pretty interesting anyway.


In Matthew we read of the account of Jesus talking about the sign of Jonah:


Matthew 12:38-42 Then some of the scribes and Pharisees said to him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from you." He answered them, "An evil and adulterous generation demands a sign, but no sign will be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah. For as Jonah was in the belly of the huge fish three days and three nights, so the Son of Man will be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights. The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, because they repented at Jonah's preaching; and look—something greater than Jonah is here. The queen of the south will rise up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and look—something greater than Solomon is here." Having read this, when Christians see the town of

Nineveh on a map of where the eclipse's line of totality lies, it sticks out to them. Then they see not only one but 7 cities named Nineveh in or around the path of the eclipse in the USA. (Only 2 actually being in the path). The number 7 in the bible is significant because it means COMPLETENESS, SPIRITUAL, and PERFECTION. The number 2 means WITNESSING, UNITY, and also DIVISION. Here is were we need to be careful, we can take this and make it mean something God has not intended. We need to stick to the facts and let God reveal His purpose or plans and not look for it to fit what we think we see.

There was an eclipse in 2017 that crosses over the one in 2024, there were 7 cities named Salem in or near that path as well. Salem is short for Jerusalem, composed of two names Salem and Yeru. Also I have read; originally "city of Shalem" Canaanite god of dusk or evening star. At some point 'shalem' lost its cultural connection to the Canaanite divinity and came to mean peace as reflected in the Hebrew root word "Salam (H7999).

These two eclipses, which are not 7 years apart as some say, they are actually 6 years, 7 months and 18 days apart according to our calendar, not the Gregorian or Jewish calendar. I would be interested to find out how far apart they are according to the Jewish calender. If you have this knowledge, please email me! \odot If you lay the paths of the 2017, 2023 and 2024 eclipses on a map you get what looks just like the Paleo Hebrew symbol for Aleph which is the first in the Hebrew Alphabet and if you just lay the 2017 and 2024 paths of the eclipse on

the map you get the Ancient Hebrew symbol Tav which is the last in the Hebrew Alphabet. God says

I am Aleph, N, and Tav, I, the beginning and the end.

Alpha and Omega the Beginning and the End.

Now, it has also come to my attention that the Constellation Cetus will be above the Eclipse on April 8, 2024, which is the whale, but further study shows it to actually be in Pisces, just one constellation over.

For my conclusion: To me this shows the Awesomeness of God. If it brings some to repentance then I say Yay God! There have been a lot of prophecies about God doing supernatural things this year, maybe this is the start. But please don't be deceived by false teachings or prophets, test them, know the Word, listen to the Holy Spirit. We must be careful not to get carried away by what the 'world' is saying or doing, and stand firm in the Word of God that will never deceive us and make sure we represent our God well.

What happens to our prayers when they leave our lips? There are many scriptures in the bible about the

There are many scriptures in the bible about the importance of prayer. Peter says God's ears attend to our prayers, John says He hears us in whatever we ask, Matthew says to watch and pray so we do not fall into temptation, Paul says to present our requests to God by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, and Jesus says to always pray and not give up. These are just a few. But what happens to our prayers once they leave our lips?

According to John's account in The Revelation of Jesus Christ, they are placed in bowls, mixed with fire and thrown to the Earth! I know, crazy right? God uses our prayers to make things happen. Revelation 5:8 When he took the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each one had a harp and golden bowls filled with incense, which are the prayers of the saints. Revelation 8:3 Another angel, with a golden incense burner, came and stood at the altar. He was given a large

amount of incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar in front of the throne. 4 The smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, went up in the presence of God from the angel's hand. 5 The angel took the incense burner, filled it with fire from the altar, and hurled it to the earth; there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake.

They are a fragrance, being mixed with incense that the angel offers at the golden altar in front of the throne of God. The smoke from the incense and the payers of the saints go up in the presence of God from the angel's hand. Then the angel mixes fire from the altar and hurls it to the earth, where peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning and earthquakes happen. A symbol of God's judgment on the earth answering the prayers of the saints. Are we praying enough? Are we filling the bowls? How long until the bowls are filled? God is waiting on us to fill those bowls so He can work His good work in the land. He has given us power and dominion. Satan deceived us into giving it up for a while, but Jesus bought it back for us on the cross! God moves when we pray. He sends angels on assignment when we cry out to Him. He is Glorified when prayers are


Know?

Ever wonder what the phrase jot and tittle meant as mentioned in Matthew 5:18? "For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled."

The word jot in Greek is translated as *iota* in Hebrew *iota* is translated *yod*, smallest letter in the Hebrew alphabet.

The word tittle in Greek is translated *keraia* in Hebrew *keraia* is translated *qotz* which means "thorn, anything like a horn, a small dot in writing"

At the time of Jesus there was a popular phrase that is translated "not a yod or a thorn of a yod". For the Hebrew speaking audience it meant something like this – "not the smallest letter or even the smallest part of the smallest letter." Jesus used that idea to drive home the importance of His word.



You may wish you could bypass the difficult emotions or push down the pain. Or maybe others are pressuring you to "get up and move on." But healing from grief and loss requires you to go through your grief. We have resources that can help you find relief and stability.

Finding support is crucial

Grief is a journey that shouldn't be traveled alone. You may feel like no one understands and be tempted to isolate, but as counselor David Bueno Martin says, "Healing happens in the context of finding others who can help you." A Grief Share group is a safe place to find support.




